Journey in Prayer Tuesday 19th March 2013

All are welcome to join Archbishop Justin on this Journey in Prayer in the days before his enthronement in Canterbury Cathedral. Archbishop Justin will be travelling around the Province of Canterbury and taking time to pray with all those who are able to join him. From March 14th – March 19th he will visit five cities and six cathedrals and everyone is invited to come along and join him in prayer. Each day will begin outside with a short time of prayer and then a walking pilgrimage to that day's focal point. Entry to each cathedral will be available free and will include prayer activities drawn from the range of Anglican spirituality: prayer trees and maps, a labyrinth, and music to inspire your prayers. Everyone is welcome to join the journey in prayer at any point. Gather in the morning, pray for the whole day, or drop in whenever you have time. Come for a few minutes or stay for a few hours, drop in and slip out whenever it suits you, you are truly welcome.
