Psalm 22.19–28

- 19 But be not thou far from me, O Lord : thou art my succour, haste thee to help me.
- 20 Deliver my soul from the sword : my darling from the power of the dog.
- 21 Save me from the lion's mouth : thou hast heard me also from among the horns of the unicorns.
- 22 I will declare thy Name unto my brethren : in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.
- 23 O praise the Lord, ye that fear him : magnify him, all ye of the seed of Jacob, and fear him, all ye seed of Israel;
- 24 For he hath not despised, nor abhorred, the low estate of the poor : he hath not hid his face from him, but when he called unto him he heard him.
